The Youth Mobile service is utilised by young people (age 14 – 24) who need a high level of support to manage their mental distress. The goal of the team is to work towards recovery and assist tāngata whaiora to function within the community. You have regular contact with tāngata whaiora visiting a minimum of twice weekly and a maximum of daily. In this role you support them in achieving their goals, seek to increase their social functioning and engagement. We work closely alongside CDHB Specialist Mental Health Services.
